POLICIES

Payments

- Payment is due one week in advance for the week that the student will be attending. This allows us to schedule and plan appropriately.
- Registration is \$25 per student.
- Full time tuition is \$100/week/first child and \$90/week/each additional child. Part time tuition is \$60/child/per week
Account balances that are late are subject to a late fee.
- If your bank returns a check due to insufficient funds, immediate payment is due to keep your child's account up to date. A \$25 fee will be charged for each returned check. If you have two returned checks in a 6-month period, you will no longer have check privileges and will be required to pay program fees in cash, in advance.
- Non-attendance does not entitle you to a refund regardless of illness, vacation, or weather cancellations.

Permissions

Emergency Care/First Aid

___ I give permission for the Director of First United Methodist Church Childcare Ministries or other personnel designated by the Director, to give or authorize emergency medical treatment or first aid or to take my child to a doctor or to the ER if necessary. I will not hold First United Methodist Church Childcare Ministries, or any staff of the church or after school care responsible in the event of an accident, injury, loss, or death.

Media

___ I permit FUMC and its Childcare Ministries to publish images of my child(ren) in internal and external material including printed material, print advertising, and promotional videos, and to Publish pictures and videos on the First United Methodist website or Facebook page. I also permit the use of my child(ren)'s image in broadcast and print media news coverage of FUMC. This includes but is not limited to Davie County Enterprise, Davie Life, Facebook, and the church website. I understand that my child's name is not published.

Movies

___ I permit my child to watch PG movies.

Transportation

When we go on a trip, we will either walk (I.e. to the park, the library, Deanos, Garden, Ice Cream shop, other locations within reasonable distance to the church) or we will take the Blue Bird Church Bus, or the White Ford Bus if it is a trip that is not within walking distance from the church.

In the white bus, if your child rides in a car seat in your personal vehicle, the same laws apply for the white bus. In order to transport your child, we must have a car seat, and it must be a car seat that is a 5 point harness car seat NOT A BOOSTER SEAT. A booster will not work in the white bus. We must have the five point harness car seat. If your child is within the range of 4 years old/40 pounds and 8 years old/80 pounds, they absolutely must have that car seat to go with us on a trip and it will need to be the 5 point harness seat. The reason for this is first and foremost because of your child's safety, but also because in the bus, the seatbelt will be secured with a lap belt, therefore it has to have the 5 point harness to be able to properly and safely secure your child.

___If by law my child rides in a car seat, I will provide a five point harness seat to be used in the white ford bus.

___ My child is outside these restrictions and can ride the white bus without a car seat.

In the Blue Bird Bus, if your child is 5 years old or older, the laws are that your child can ride in the bus without a car seat. They will be secured with a lap belt only. If you prefer to send a car seat, again it must be a five point harness car seat so that it can properly be secured in the bus and your child can be safely secured.

___ My child can be secured with a lap belt only in the Blue Bird Bus.

___ I would prefer my child ride in a car seat in the Blue Bird Bus and will provide a five point harness seat for them to ride in.

___ My child has permission to walk to places deemed appropriate by First UMC After School or Summer Day Camo

___ My child does NOT have permission to walk to locations outside of First UMC campus

Other

- I understand that FUMC Mocksville and their staff or volunteers are not responsible for any accidents, injury or loss or damage that my child may obtain while attending Summer Day Camp, and agree to hold FUMC Mocksville and their staff or volunteers harmless from any liability they may incur.
- Participants are responsible for their own accident insurance while attending First United Methodist Church After School Care or Summer Day Camp.
- FUMC is not responsible for any items that are lost or stolen.
- FUMC does not normally administer any medications and will only do so when proper written documentation, together with written parental consent giving that permission for such emergency medications as administration of an epi-pen injection. Such medication must be supplied by the parent in all cases. In the event of an emergency in which the parent cannot be contacted, local public Emergency Medical Staff and FUMC may take the appropriate action in the best interest of the child.
