Maybe you will even decide to sit with someone you don't know well and get to know them better. Having combined services will give everyone the opportunity for getting to know someone from the worship service they do not usually attend. Each Sunday you will have the opportunity to write down a prayer request. These will be kept confidential and only seen by Hannah and Lori Anne who will lift the requests in prayer during the week. Sunday, July 28, there will be a covered dish meal after the service. Several people from the Correctional Facility in Winston Salem will be our guest storytellers that day, and we want to welcome them with a hearty meal. Please bring a dish or two and plan to stay and enjoy additional time getting to know one another. Jesus was a storyteller. His disciples knew him better through the stories he shared. The stories of their life with Jesus helps us know him too. We might just see Jesus in someone else and ourselves.
